COOPER CENTER VENDOR AGREEMENT
SUNDAY FARMER'S MARKET for January 2010**

TO SUPPORT SMOOTH OPERATIONS, VENDORS AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. Pay fees as set by Cooper Center at a per table space, if you leave early, you take the fee to the proper individual. (Cooper Center end \$15 per space (to Linda), Covered Court \$10 per space to Steve)
2. Be at the Cooper Center, offloaded, car moved into the GRAVEL PARKING lot next to firehouse, and ready to sell by 6:30AM. Exception is for the sidewalk vendors near covered court, they must park in space WITHOUT blocking sidewalk, or using the handicapped spaces. All Vendors must supply information below.

3. **VENDORS MAY NOT BRING ANY ANIMALS INTO THE MARKET, NO EXCEPTIONS, IT'S AGAINST COUNTY RULES.**
4. Put away cleaned and dry tables, in appropriate location at the of the Market, at 9AM:
 - Large tables with a white edge go next to the exit door next to the pastry vendor (Joyce).
 - Unmarked wooden tables go against the wall behind the fireplace.
 - Plastic tables go in two piles on the back wall, with room for 3 stacks chairs in between.
 - At the Covered Court. Clean ground area around your tables, safety issue for skaters, and be out by 10:15am
5. For the Cooper Center end of the market, if you are a regular vendor with a regular spot, and you will NOT be coming, you will be required to contact Linda Ugalde at 936-9705 no later than 7:00 P.M. on Saturday. If you do not notify us of your absence, we will consider that you no longer have a regular spot, and will be placed only where space is available.
6. Anyone selling any prepared goods must have a State Department of Health Certificate in good standing. New law requires egg sellers to have a permit for this also. (New in 2009).
7. All produce vendors promise that items they are selling are grown by them, or by friends and handling the items on consignment basis not as a 3rd party reselling the items. (In other words you may not go to a market, buy vegetables and sell them at Cooper Center.)
8. Crafters must attest that they have made their items, or that they are made by friends and you are handling the items on consignment and not as a 3rd party reselling items. You may buy items and decorate it, but not just resell it. (you may not go buy items elsewhere, and resell at Cooper Center).

Please read completely sign and return page two only, keep page one so you can refer to what you have signed. If you do not adhere to these rules, Cooper Center reserves to the right to refuse to allow you to setup for violating any of the rules set forth above.
